Beyond Pet Parenthood: The Evolution of Queer Family-Making



For generations, we were told—explicitly and implicitly—that parenthood wasn't for us. The narrative was clear: queerness and raising children were incompatible.

Many of us channelled our nurturing instincts into caring for beloved pets, creating families of choice with friends, and finding other meaningful ways to express love and care.

While pet parenthood remains a valid and joyful choice for many, the landscape has fundamentally shifted. Today, we're building families through a remarkable array of pathways, and in doing so, we're not just raising children—we're reshaping what family means for everyone.

This guide is for us. Whether you're already parenting, actively planning, or just beginning to imagine what your family might look like, you belong here. Your journey is valid, your family is real and you're part of a vibrant community of queer parents who are changing the world, one family at a time.



The Many Pathways to Parenthood

Our parenting is as diverse as our community itself. There is no single route to becoming a queer parent, and this diversity is one of our greatest strengths. Here are some of the paths we're taking.

Adoption and Fostering

Many of us have built our families through adoption and fostering. In the UK, we've been able to adopt jointly as same-sex couples since 2005, and countless children have found loving homes with us.

Fostering is another powerful way we're making a difference—providing stability and love to children who need it most. Many of us have welcomed children who've experienced trauma, and we know the profound healing that a safe, loving queer family can provide.

If you're considering this path, know that there's a whole community of LGBTQIA+ adopters and foster carers ready to support you.

Surrogacy

For many of us—particularly gay men and male couples—surrogacy has opened doors that were once closed. Whether through traditional or gestational surrogacy, this path requires navigating legal, ethical, and emotional considerations, but the reward is immeasurable.

Many of us have built beautiful relationships with our surrogates, who often become part of our extended family networks. These bonds enrich our children's lives with additional caring adults who love them.

More Routes to Building Your Family

Assisted Reproduction

IUI, IVF, and other assisted reproductive technologies have helped so many of us—particularly lesbian couples and single parents—bring children into our lives. We're using known donors, anonymous donors, and everything in between.

Increasingly, many of us are choosing to maintain connections with donors, creating expansive family structures where our children benefit from multiple caring adults. There's no one right way to do this—it's about what works for your family.

Co-Parenting Arrangements

Some of us are getting creative with co-parenting—raising children with friends or other community members in intentional arrangements outside traditional models. Maybe it's a gay man and lesbian woman parenting together, or multiple adults sharing responsibilities across households.

These configurations showcase something we've always known: family is what we make it.

Blended Families

Many of us bring children from previous relationships into new family configurations. We're navigating step-parenting, co-parenting with exes, and helping our children adjust to new dynamics. It's complex, beautiful, and deeply rewarding.

If this is your path, you're not alone—and your blended family is just as real and valid as any other.

What We Know About Our Families

Let's be clear: we don't need external validation to know our families are thriving. But it's worth celebrating what the evidence confirms—our kids are doing brilliantly.

Our children show strong outcomes across the board:

- Emotional wellbeing
- Social development
- Academic achievement
- Psychological adjustment
- Quality of family relationships

What Makes Our Families Strong

Our kids often develop qualities we can be proud of:

Deep empathy — Growing up in families that have navigated difference, our children understand what it means to walk in someone else's shoes.

Flexible thinking — Our kids learn early that there's no single way to be a family, a partner, or a person. They're not constrained by rigid expectations.

Appreciation for diversity — Our children see difference as something to celebrate, not fear.

The Real Challenge

When our kids do face difficulties, it's rarely about our family structure—it's about how the world responds to us. Stigma and discrimination are the real issues, which is exactly why visibility and advocacy matter so much.

Our families aren't just surviving—we're thriving. And we're raising the next generation of allies and advocates.





How We're Shaping the Future

By building our families, we're not just creating homes for our children—we're transforming society. Here's how we're making a difference.

Expanding What Family Means

Every time we show up as a family—at the school gates, at the GP surgery, at the park—we're expanding what "family" looks like. We're living proof that love, commitment, and nurturing are what make a family, not biology or tradition.

This doesn't just benefit us. Every family that doesn't fit the conventional mould—single parents, grandparents raising grandchildren, chosen families of all kinds—benefits when we broaden the definition.

Parenting with Intention

None of us became parents by accident. Every one of us made a deliberate choice to bring children into our lives. We've reflected deeply, navigated obstacles, and made conscious decisions about how we want to raise our kids.

That intentionality shows. We're engaged, thoughtful parents who've fought for the privilege of raising our children.

Modelling Equal Partnership

Many of us are showing our children what equal partnership looks like. Without falling into gendered assumptions about who does what, we're dividing responsibilities based on skills, preferences, and fairness. Our kids are growing up seeing that partnership means teamwork—not rigid roles.



Raising the Next Generation

Building Resilience

Our children learn to navigate a world that doesn't always understand their families. That's not easy, but it builds resilience. Many of our kids become advocates themselves—standing up against injustice and championing diversity.

We're raising young people with the strength and empathy the world desperately needs.

Creating Change in Our Communities

We don't just advocate for our own kids—we work to make spaces better for everyone. We're pushing for:

- Inclusive curricula that reflect all families
- Diverse representation in books, TV, and media
- Policies that protect and support all families
- Welcoming spaces in schools, healthcare, and community organisations

When we advocate, the ripple effects benefit all children and families, not just ours.

Living Our Chosen Family Values

We've always understood that family extends beyond biology and legal ties. Chosen family—the people who show up for us, who love us, who belong to us regardless of blood—is central to queer life.

As parents, we're passing this on to our children. We're teaching them that love creates family. That belonging is something we build together. That the people who choose to love you are just as important as the people you're born to.

Whether you're years into parenting or just starting to dream about what your family might look like, know this: you belong here.

The path to parenthood isn't always straightforward for us. There are forms that don't fit our families, professionals who don't understand, and systems that weren't designed with us in mind. But we navigate them anyway. We advocate for ourselves and each other. We build the families we want.

And we're not doing it alone.

There's a whole community of LGBTQIA+ parents and parents-to-be out there. People who get it. People who've been where you are. People who'll celebrate your wins and support you through the hard bits.

You have always known how to love fiercely.

You have always known how to create family intentionally.

Now, as you raise the next generation, you're not just changing your own life—you're helping to build a more compassionate, inclusive world for all families.
